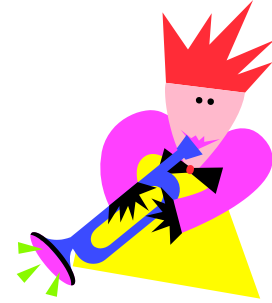


# Waterway No. 1 Work Party

**What is Waterway #1?** Waterway No. 1 is a parcel of waterfront property located where Northeast 35<sup>th</sup> Street meets 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue Northeast. Long ago it was used as a boat launch for one of Seattle's mosquito fleet ferries, the Laurelhurst Launch, which shuttled folks from Laurelhurst to Madison Park and back. Now it is a rare and treasured public access point to the waterfront where people can go to observe nature, walk dogs, and launch non-motorized boats. Neighbors adopted a concept plan to improve the waterway in September 2005. Some progress has been made, but it's time to move forward to continue to implement the plan. Your help is needed to transform the waterway into a community amenity for all to enjoy.
